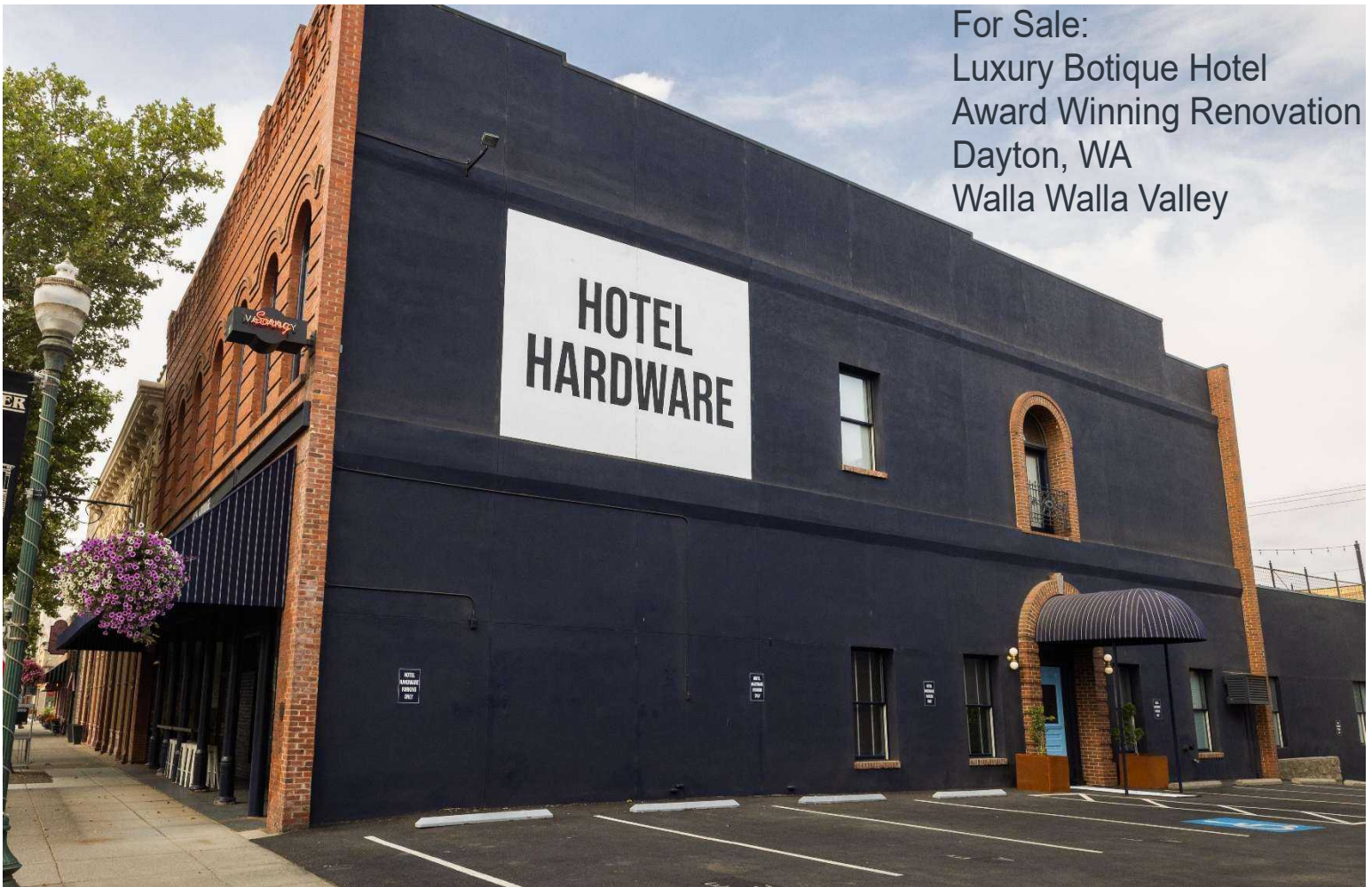

The famed landmarked building was built in 1890 by beer mogul Jacob Weinhard, nephew of Henry Wienhard. The property rests in the comforting shadow of the Bluewood Maintains/Umatilla National Forest and the roaming hills of the Palouse. In the hotel's brief existence, the Hotel Hardware has caught the attention of the Seattle Times, 1889 Magazine, Northwest Travel Magazine, and Seattle Met. The owners no longer live in market and are running it passively. Tremendous upside in activating the hotel to its operational potential.
